



Homestay Services

Before Departure

- Email all forms necessary to apply for homestay, including Parental Consent to Custodianship (which CHI requires in English and in the first language of the student's parents);
- courier a notarized Declaration of Custodianship upon completed and notarized Parental Consent to Custodianship;
- email a profile of the host family selected for the student by CHI after careful consideration;
- arrange for the student to be met at the airport and brought to his or her homestay;
- facilitate the application process;

Upon Arrival

- Ensure that the student is accompanied to the immunization validation, academic assessment, school registration and orientation appointments before school starts;
- provide a formal orientation to prepare students for their experience in homestay;
- ensure that the student is supported as they learn to take public transit, access a health clinic, open a bank account, and so on;

During Homestay

- meet with the student to assess their overall experience;
- help the student communicate effectively with their host as needed;
- facilitate the student's choice of classes each semester if needed;
- assess the student's report cards and facilitate academic case conferences as needed;
- assist the student to complete the study permit renewal application if applicable;
- provide emergency support, anytime it is needed, 24 hours per day, 7 days per week
